



# UICC Master Courses

## Guidelines for Participants

Master Courses are purpose-built online educational activities. The tailor-made nature of the content and online delivery makes them a unique platform to meet the specific needs for continuing education of those engaged in cancer control from various disciplines and at different levels.

### What is expected from Participants?

Individuals from UICC member organisations are eligible to apply, free of charge, for one of the Master Courses on offer. Applications can be made via the UICC Master course webpages starting from late April. Limited places are available on each course, hence selection will take place for over-subscribed courses.

### Master Course Participants are expected to:

1. Follow the online course as instructed by the course leaders through webinars, narrated slides and additional reading (the online component of each course has been designed so to be compatible with the busy schedule of full-time employed professionals).
2. Complete any online assignments and quizzes within the specified timeframe.
3. Contribute to online discussions related to the course content with peers via the online discussion forum.
4. Complete the evaluation surveys at the beginning and end of the course.
5. Contact your course leader or UICC ([education@uicc.org](mailto:education@uicc.org)) if you encounter any problems that prevent you from accessing content or completing the course.
