### Short-term opportunities for senior executives to mentor and shadow peers

To have impact at scale, UICC is committed to strengthening its member organisations in their own context and area of work. In particular, UICC has developed a package of capacity building activities to engage and support senior executives of UICC Member organisations. One of the components of this flagship CEO Programme are regional events, titled '**Leadership in Action**', designed to provide opportunities for peer-to-peer learning and networking with individuals working in similar regional contexts.

In conjunction with the next Leadership in Action meeting for Latin America, which takes place on 13 November 2017 in advance of the World Cancer Leaders Summit in Mexico, UICC is piloting a new opportunity: '**Short-term Leadership Development Grants**'. Participants in the Leadership in Action meeting in Latin America are offered the opportunity to learn from their peers in the region through the funding of **short-term learning visits to other organisations**.

#### What is this new opportunity for CEOs?



- Individual grants of up to 1700 USD. A **maximum of 5 are available**.
- For UICC Member CEOs participating in the Leadership in Action meeting (or other senior staff members of their choice)
- Visits of up to 10 days to be conducted in 2018 to another UICC Member in the region
- Topics on organisational management as well as cancer control and public health depending on the CEOs needs

# Concept & Process

## LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT GRANTS for senior executives to learn from their peers and initiate or foster collaborations at the regional level

### Eligibility

- CEOs participating in the Leadership in Action meeting for Latin America, held on 13 November (or nominated staff members from their organisation)
- Completed application, including an invitation letter from the host organisation

### Visits

- Visits of up to 10 days, to be implemented in 2018
  - Focus of the visit should be on individual learning on organisational management topics as well as on cancer control and public health depending on the CEOs needs
- Examples of topics:
- How to reach new donors through targeted fundraising campaigns?
  - How to better recruit and engage volunteers? How to partner with key stakeholders?
  - How to launch a project aiming to provide cancer services?
- Conducted with another [UICC Member from the region](#)

### HOW CAN I APPLY?



- Identify what you would like to learn from a peer (see the booklet)
- Identify a host organisation and, connect in person at the Leadership in Action meeting in November
- Complete the form, including an invitation letter from the host organisation and an estimated budget (UICC's contribution is of a maximum of 1700 USD)
- Send all application materials before 8 December to [regionalcb@uicc.org](mailto:regionalcb@uicc.org)

### Selection

This opportunity for **five Leadership Development Grants** is a pilot activity closely linked to the Leadership in Action Meeting in Latin America. The selection will be made based on the relevance, feasibility of the learning visit, suitability of the host organisation and opportunity for future collaborations. Results will be announced on 22 December 2017.

### Deliverables

Selected candidates commit to:

- Conduct their visit in 2018
- Participate in two interviews, one before and one after the visit for evaluation purposes
- Provide photos and/or videos of their visits
- Prepare a short testimonial to be published on UICC website or blog.
